AuSM Social Skills Classes

Led by autism experts, AuSM social skills classes foster confidence and self-esteem while participants make friends, interact with a group, practice socializing, and have fun – all while educators encourage participants to be themselves. Classes offer low-stress, accepting environments that promote learning and growth while celebrating neurodiversity. Class venues include CsZ Twin Cities, Toneworks, Como Park Zoo and Conservatory, and others.

AuSM Autism Training

AuSM provides state-wide trainings on autism and related topics, including anxiety, autism and employment, practical and inclusion strategies, emergency preparedness, and transition needs.

AuSM Skillshops

AuSM Skillshops are a skill-building series of workshops for people who care for individuals on the autism spectrum.
