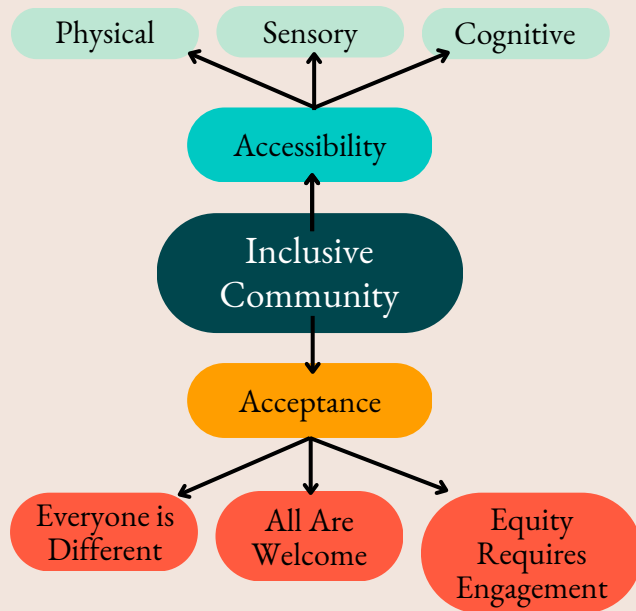


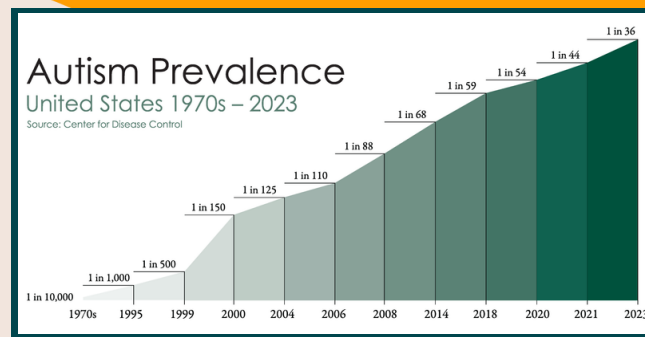
# Create Inclusion
