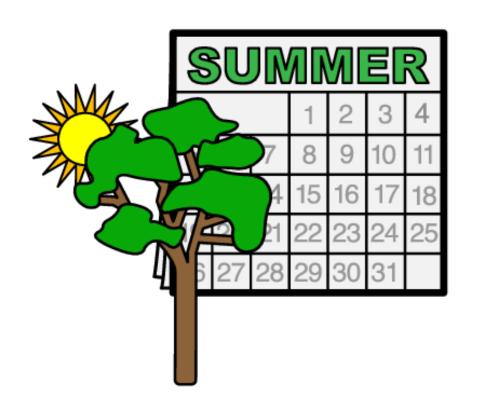

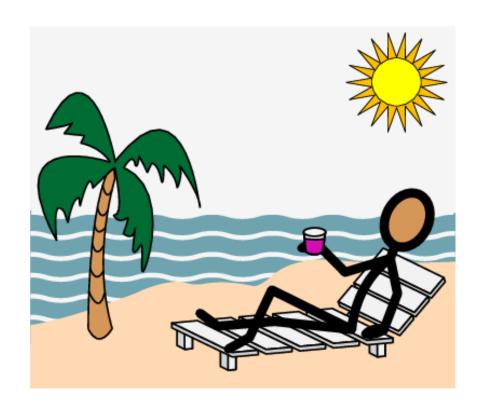

This summer, I am going up to Camp Hand in Hand.

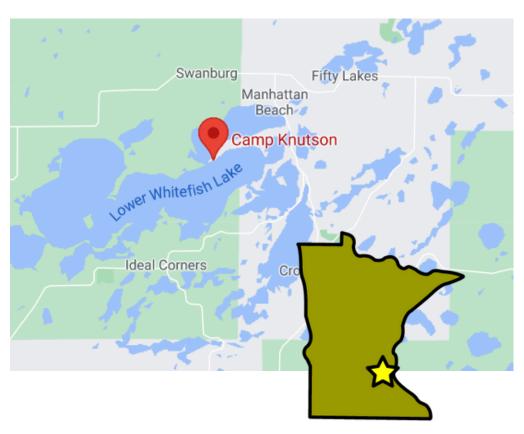






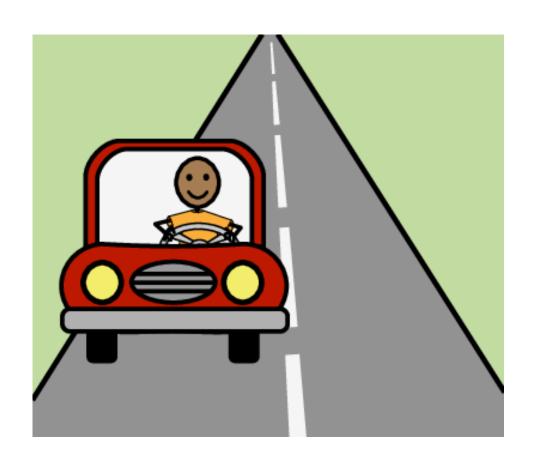
This camp is at Camp Knutson in Crosslake, Minnesota.

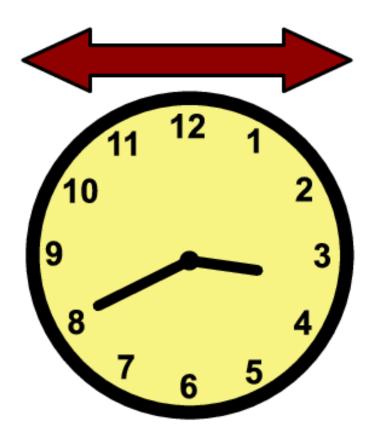






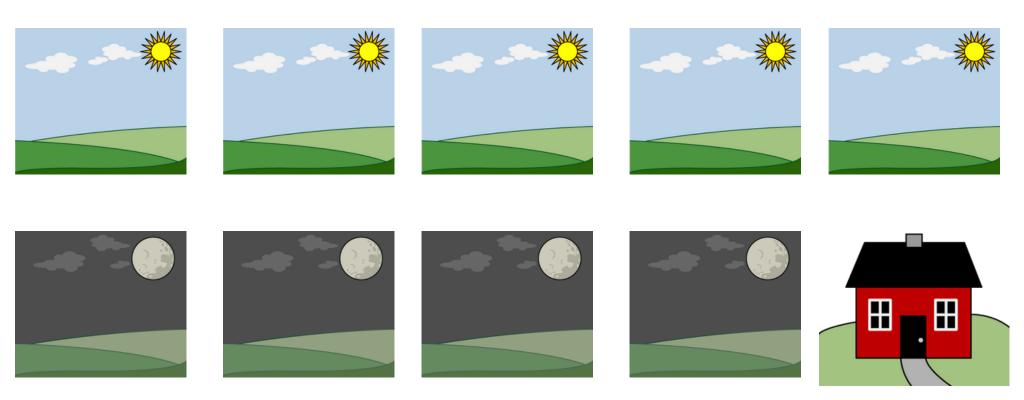
I might have to drive a long time to get there.





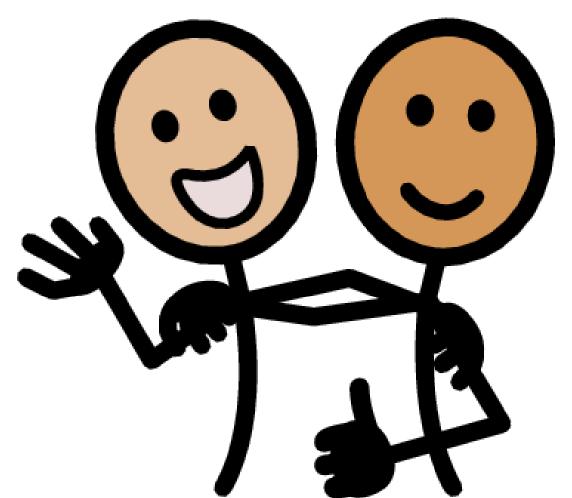


I will stay at Camp Hand in Hand for 4 nights and 5 days. Then I will go home.



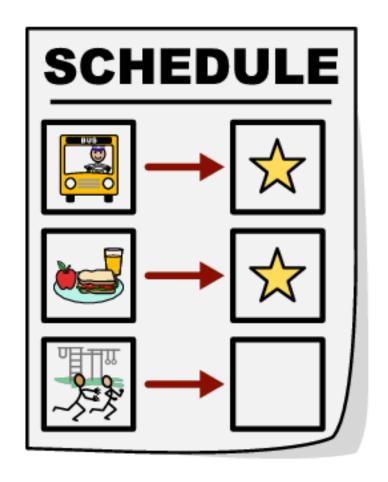


At camp, there will be someone who is my buddy throughout the week. They are there to help me. They are called a counselor.





At camp, there will be a schedule of events.



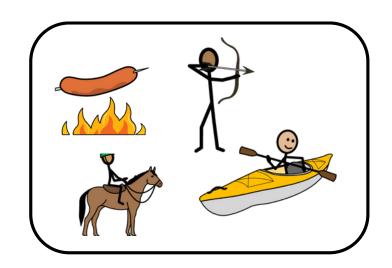


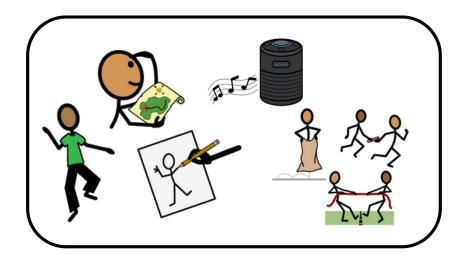
We will eat breakfast, lunch, and dinner outside at tables.

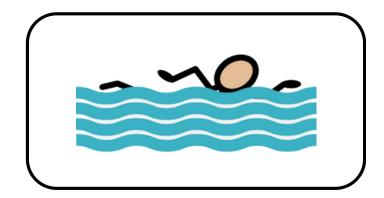




The schedule will have: morning rotations, swimming, and evening activities.







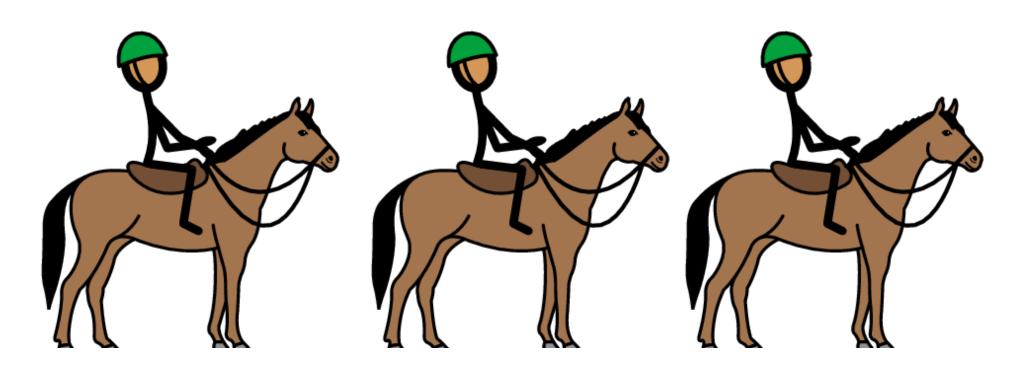


Morning rotations will include activities like: archery, cooking, canoeing, etc.



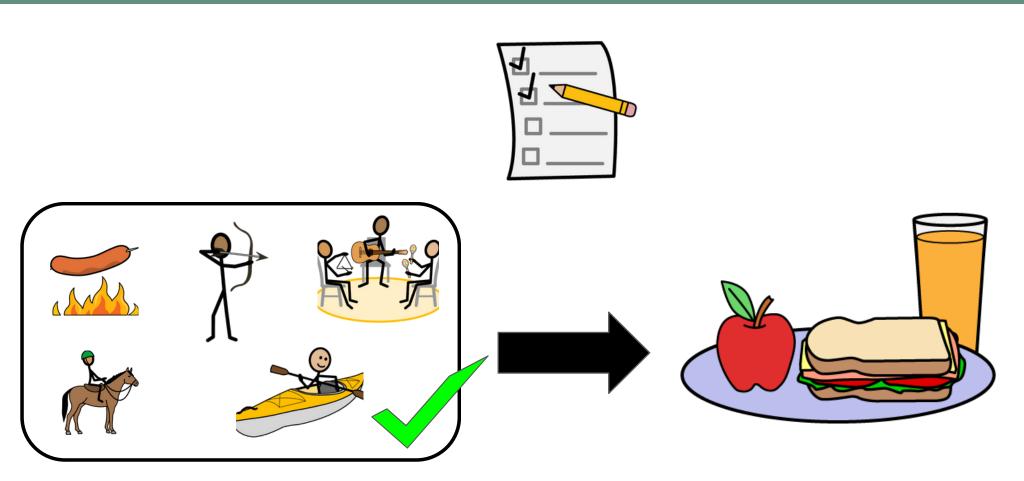


I will get to go horseback riding during a morning rotation.



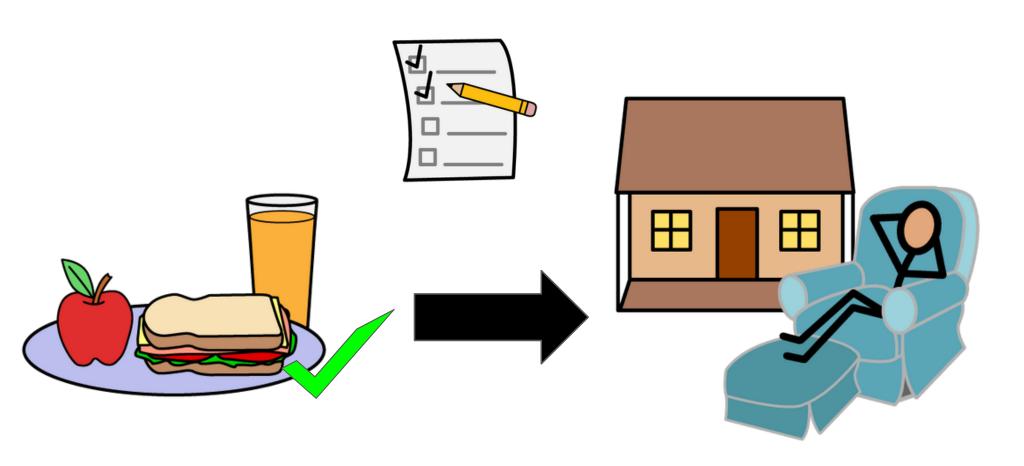


When my morning rotation is done, I will have lunch.



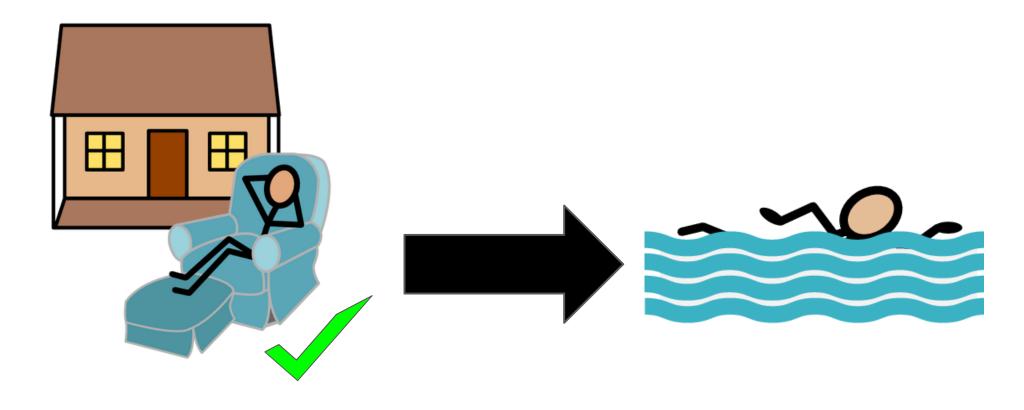


After lunch, I will have relaxation time in my bunk.



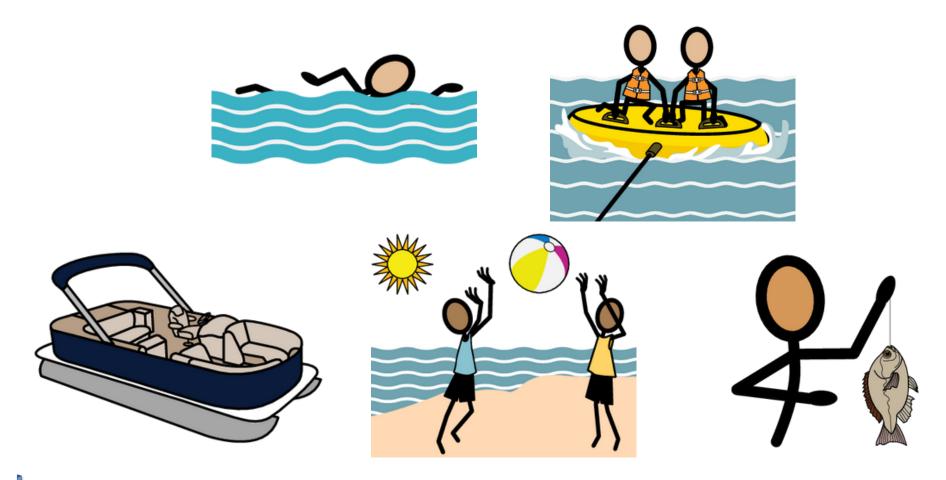


After relaxation, I get to go swimming.



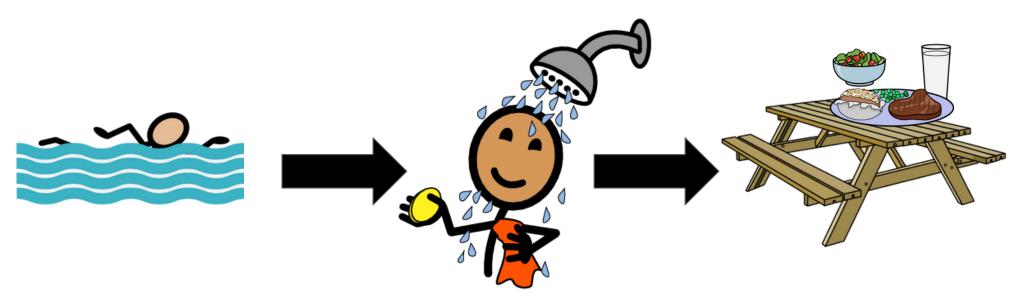


Swimming time will include a chance to go swim, hang out on the beach, go on a pontoon, go tubing, or go fishing.





After swimming, I will shower and then have dinner.





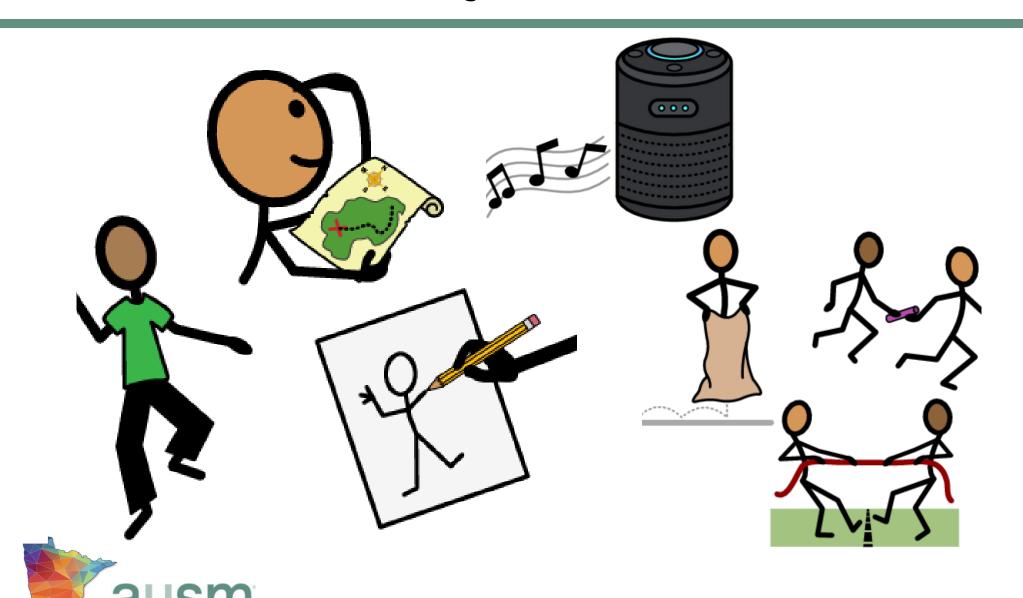
I can do recreation when I am done eating dinner. The options might be bikes, gaga ball, or basketball.



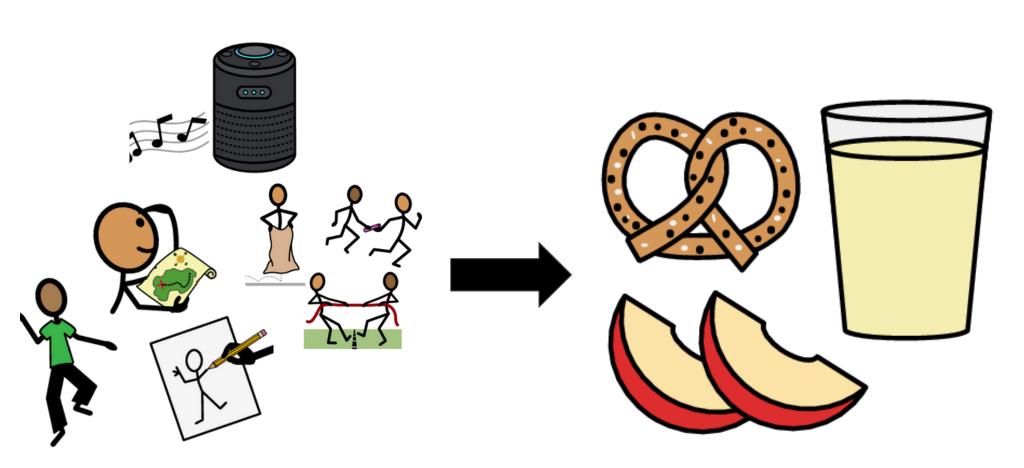




Evening activities will be after recreation and have a fun theme with different games and activities.

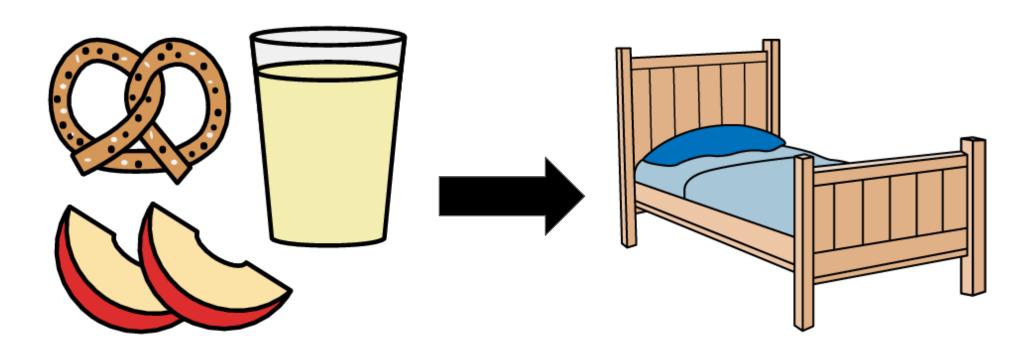


When evening activities are over, I will get to have a snack.

I will sleep in a cabin with my group.

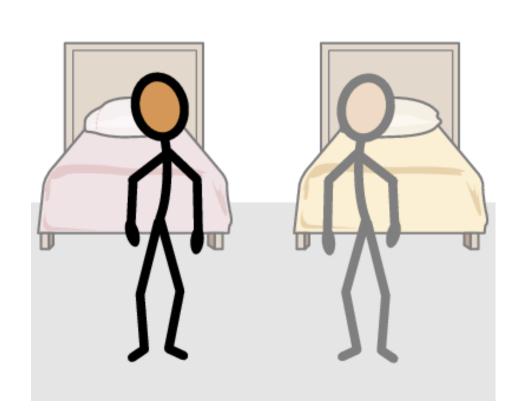








I might sleep in a bunk bed and have a roommate.
