MORE THAN 400 PEOPLE ATTENDED OUR SUPPORT GROUPS IN 2023, INCLUDING WOMEN'S SUPPORT GROUP, LGBTQIA+ SUPPORT GROUP, INDEPENDENT ADULTS WITH ASD SUPPORT GROUP, AND FAMILY MEMBERS OF ADULTS ON THE SPECTRUM SUPPORT GROUP.
