

Deaf parents of autistic children, ages 3 to 6

A Miami University study you can take part in entirely from home. No clinic visits, no travel.



What taking part involves

- ✓ Answer questions online from home (about 30 to 60 minutes)
- ✓ Receive a free kit by mail: toys, a book, a beanbag toss game, and a tripod
- ✓ Record one 15 to 30 minute play session with your child at home
- ✓ Upload the video through a secure portal
- ✓ Keep everything sent to you. The toys and tripod are yours

Your family may be a fit if

- ✓ You are a Deaf parent or legal guardian
- ✓ Your child is 3 to 6 years old with an autism spectrum disorder diagnosis
- ✓ Your child is deaf or hearing. Both are welcome
- ✓ You have a smartphone or other device that records video, with internet access

This study is not a fit if your child has a severe intellectual disability, a genetic syndrome, or a significant motor or vision impairment. Families receive up to \$100, and the whole commitment is about 1 to 2 hours. Taking part is voluntary and you may stop at any time.
